APRICA

The lively village of Aprica has a superb range of skiing for all abilities and is surrounded by unspoilt alpine landscapes. There are extensive nursery slopes ideal for first year skiers. The Palabione ski area is the highest in the region - it rises to an altitude of 2440 metres (and includes a World Cup racing piste!). The ski slopes lie between 1200 and 2300 meters allowing testing and exhilarating skiing for advanced skiers with a long black run descending back to the village. The locals, as most Italians, love children and are quickly made to feel at home. The resort is undoubtedly an excellent choice for families.

WHERE YOU STAY

Hotel Aprica

This 3 Star hotel is ideally situated in the centre of Aprica and only a short walk to the lifts. Each room has private en-suite facilities and families are based in room of four. The hotel offers a comfortable lounge, TV room and panoramic dining room serving local and international cuisine.

BORMIO

The gorgeous medieval spa town of Bormio is regularly voted the most beautiful ski resort in the world and is perfect for those who want the complete winter experience. Beginners can relax in the gondolas and then progress on to the gentle blue runs with fantastic conditions. There's brilliant skiing for intermediates, with very long runs through trees. For intermediates looking for a challenge, there's an exhilarating 14 km descent from the Cima Bianca cable car right down into the village itself. Advanced skiers also have some of the best powder and off-piste in Italy.

WHERE YOU STAY

Hotel Capitani

This is a superb 3 Star family run hotel located in the centre of Bormio and only 10 minutes by foot to the lifts. All rooms have private en-suite facilities, telephones and TV. PASSO TONALE

Passo Tonale is situated on the high mountain pass at the head of the Val Vermiglio, straddling the provinces of Trento and Lombardy. With an altitude of 1800 meters and most skiing above the tree line, good snow cover is guaranteed. There are 80 km of pistes, and these are ideally suited to beginners and intermediates. Beginners' nursery slopes are linked to the many blue runs, which make it convenient to achieve fast and satisfying progress onto more challenging slopes.

WHERE YOU STAY

Hotel Bella Vista

The Hotel Bellavista is perfectly situated on the centre of Pontedilegno and only a short walk to the lifts. This is a friendly, family run 3 Star hotel and offers 41 spacious rooms, all equipped with personal services, telephone, and television. ST. GERVAIS

Situated at the foot of Mont Blanc, the old Roman spa town of St. Gervais is without doubt one of the most fashionable resorts in the French Alps. ZELL AM SEE

WHERE YOU STAY

Hotel Der Wildbachof

This friendly family run gasthof is ideally situated with the Schmitten areas of Zell. All rooms are en-suite and recently refurbished. The Schmittenhohebahn lift is only a 300 metre walk from the gasthof and more experienced skiers can often ski back to the front door.
